Many of the athletic fields in Sharon are in poor condition. Our student-athletes deserve safe, playable fields. There are few if any suitable locations to build new fields in Sharon without destroying the natural open spaces and wildlife habitat that make Sharon special (check out the wildlife sightings at: http://www.sharonfoc.org). Thus, we need to provide good maintenance for the fields we have.

A group of concerned residents is working on an initiative to hire a professional to analyze the fields and formulate a maintenance plan to significantly improve them. This fall, we want to upgrade four of Sharon's dozen fields as a sort of pilot project to demonstrate the effectiveness of this approach. The cost for analyzing the fields and formulating a plan is \$2,500, which includes five years of monitoring and advice by Tom Irwin Advisors to ensure the success of the program.

The four fields we have selected are the High School, Ames Street, East Elementary, and Gavins Pond Road. We are asking the Town to underwrite the High School field, and we have asked three sports organizations; Sharon Youth Lacrosse, Sharon Soccer and Sharon Youth Baseball; to raise \$2,500 each for maintenance plans for the other three fields. The Sharon DPW already has a budget for the actual maintenance work, but we believe that professional maintenance plans based on scientific analyses of actual conditions at each field would help strategically allocate those funds for maximum benefit.
